Hwy 80 just west of Mile Marker 299  
7 Miles South of Benson

**2. Original 1920 Apache Powder Company (Now Apache Nitrogen Products - Private Property)**  
1436 S. Apache Powder Road

**3. St. David Cienega**  
Past Apache Nitrogen, End of S. Cary Road at San Pedro River Trail. Parking and hiking trails available at the Land Cattle Company Corral.

**4. Historic Trees Along the Irrigation Ditch**  
Along Hwy 80 (See Green Line on Map)

**5. Pecan Orchards (Representative)**  
Sybil Road, ¼ Mile from Hwy 80

**6. Mormon Battalion Monument**  
Hwy 80 and Church Street  
(Parking Available on South Side of Hwy 80)

**7. Goodman Family Palm Tree Circa 1902, Site of St. David Store and Post Office**  
Across Hwy 80 from the Mormon Battalion Monument

**8. Historic 1938 St. David Elementary School and Bell Monument, Current St. David Schools**  
70 E. Patton Street

**9. Original CCC Camp and Twin Lakes Artesian Wells at the St. David RV Resort**  
801 S. Lee Street (View Only)

**10. Holy Trinity Monastery**  
1605 S. St. Marys Way  
Birding, hiking, and gift shop on site.

**11. Rammed Earth Round House at the Site of the 1880s Schoolhouse and Original Town Site. 1887 Playground Cottonwood Tree (Largest in Area) Remains to the Northwest**  
Hwy 80 and 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, Across from Mile Marker 303. (Parking on East Side of Hwy 80 at the Historic Marker Sign)

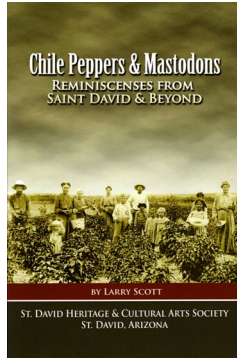
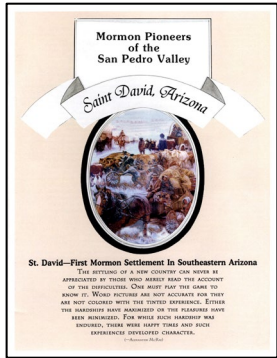
**12. St. David Cemetery and Old Fort Footprint**
